Graffiti Workshop Policy Notice

Effective from 25th May 2026

Leake Street Arches is formalising its approach to graffiti workshops within the tunnel. From 25th May 2026, only workshops delivered as part of the official **LSA Artist in Residence Programme** will be permitted within the Arches. Unauthorised and unofficial workshops will not be permitted to take place in the space.

This does not affect general use of the tunnel. Leake Street Arches will continue to operate as an open and accessible space for artists and members of the public to enjoy, paint and create art.

This policy specifically relates to organised, paid workshops and classes being run without approval. From this date onwards, only officially authorised LSA Artist in Residence workshops will be permitted to operate within the space.

As the operators of the Arches, we are required to ensure that any commercial activity taking place within the venue is properly managed and authorised, in the same way that any other venue or landlord is required to manage business activity operating within their premises.

Please also refer to the published Tunnel Rules, which set out the wider requirements for use of the space, including:

- Restrictions on branding, advertising, and offensive content
- Requirements for events and organised activity to be authorised
- Confirmation that workshops are delivered solely through the LSA Artist in Residence programme
